AI Overview

Labeling a 144-core optical cable requires using a structured color-coding system for fibers and buffer tubes, combined with clear, durable cable labels at endpoints and along the run.

Fiber and Tube Color Coding

A 144-core cable typically contains 12 buffer tubes, each with 12 fibers. Identification relies on a two-level color system:

- **Buffer Tube Colors:** Follow the TIA/EIA-598-C standard sequence: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua. Tube 1 is Blue, Tube 2 is Orange, and so on .
- **Fiber Colors within Tubes:** Each fiber in a tube uses the same 12-color sequence. For example, Fiber #34 is the 10th fiber in Tube 3 (Green), making it a Violet fiber inside the Green tube .
- **High-Density Designs:** If a tube contains more than 12 fibers, tracer rings or stripes are added to distinguish fibers beyond the first 12 . This system allows technicians to trace any fiber from the ODF to the splice point without confusion.

Cable Labeling Practices

For physical labeling of the cable:

- **Cable Identifier:** Use an alphanumeric code, e.g., "FB-03-A144," where FB = fiber, 03 = zone/floor, A144 = cable number .
- **Source and Destination:** Clearly mark endpoints, e.g., "Server Rack 12A to IDF-3" .
