They are ideal for enterprise networks, industrial automation, CCTV systems, and mid-sized data hubs. The extra cores allow multiple simultaneous connections or future expansion without replacing the pigtail .

Pigtail Boxes

- **2-Core Pigtail Box:** Typically smaller, designed to terminate and protect two fibers. It is suitable for short-range connections and environments where only a single Tx/Rx pair is needed. These boxes provide mechanical protection, organized slack management, and support fusion splicing .
- **4-Core Pigtail Box:** Often a surface-mount fiber termination box with multiple adapter slots (e.g., 4 SC/APC ports). It integrates fiber splicing, termination, and storage, making it suitable for residential buildings, small business premises, or villas. The dual-layer design ensures proper bend radius and organized fiber management, supporting up to four pigtails and patch cables .
