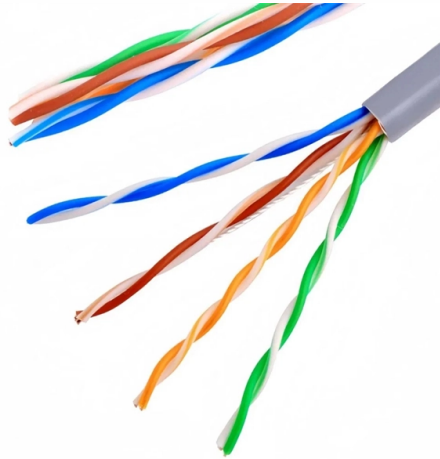

Purpose of Markings

- Neutral and Ground Bars: Connection points for white (neutral) and bare/green (ground) wires .
- Special Protection Labels: Circuits with GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) or AFCI (Arc Fault Circuit Interrupter) protection should be clearly marked .
- Numbering: Each breaker is usually numbered to match a directory or panel chart for easy identification .
