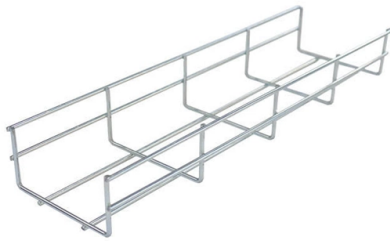


Can ordinary fiber optic cables be stacked with switches



Overview

To connect multiple Ethernet switches, the best way is to use a multi-strand fiber cable. The 4-strand pre-terminated fiber optic cable consists of four individual strands or fibers of glass or plastic fibers enclosed in a protective sheath. (lets say 4 Meters distance between racks). Thanks. It usually depends on the model of the switches. When connecting stack cables, pay attention to the following points: The maximum length of an optical fiber or optical cable is 10 m. If traffic needs to be forwarded through stack cables. Other than entry level network switches, most of today's network switches include one or more GiBC (Gigabit Converter) or SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) slots. SFP modules insert into these slots and and require two strands of fiber, typically duplex Using multi mode fiber (for runs under 1000. A stacking cable is a high-performance...
