

Core Switch IP Mapping



AI Overview

Core switch IP mapping involves configuring VLAN interfaces, loopback addresses, static routes, and correlating MAC addresses to IPs for management and routing purposes.

Configuring Core Switch IPs for Management and Routing

Management IP: Assign a dedicated IP address to a VLAN interface on the core switch to enable management access. This IP should be reachable from your network management system, such as iMaster NCE-Campus for Huawei devices, and may require configuring a static route pointing to the management network . **VLAN Interfaces:** Each VLAN that the core switch participates in should have an IP address assigned to its corresponding interface. This allows the core switch to route traffic between VLANs and participate in Layer 3 routing protocols like OSPF . For example, if you have multiple distribution switches, each L3 link between the core and distribution devices should have its own subnet and IP addresses. **Loopback Interfaces:** Configure a loopback interface with a /32 IP address for each core switch. Loopbacks are used as router IDs in OSPF and for management purposes such as Telnet, SSH, or SNMP . **Static Routes:** Define static routes on the core switch to reach management systems or other critical network segments. For Huawei devices, this includes configuring a static route to the iMaster NCE-Campus controller with the next hop pointing to the management switch . **NETCONF/SSH Management:** Enable NETCONF over SSH or Callhome mode for centralized management. This allows the controller to communicate with the core switch for configuration and monitoring .
