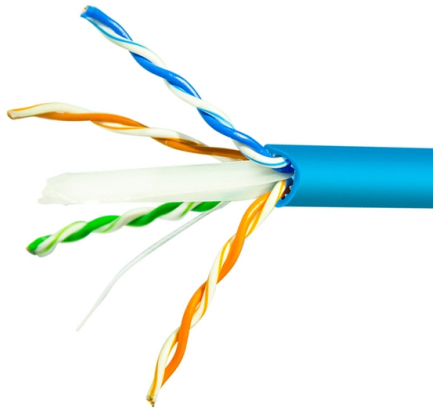


Distance between gas pipes and cable trays



AI Overview

The minimum recommended distance between cable trays and gas pipes is generally 300 mm for parallel runs and 20-50 mm at crossing points, with additional considerations for gas density and maintenance access.

Parallel Runs

For cable trays running parallel to gas pipes, a minimum clearance of 300 mm (30 cm) is recommended to ensure safety, allow heat dissipation, and provide space for maintenance work. In some regulations, gas pipes should be positioned at least 100 mm above electrical installations if the gas is lighter than air, or below electrical cables if the gas is heavier than air. Crossing Points

When cable trays cross gas pipes perpendicularly, a minimum clearance of 20 mm (2 cm) is generally required. This ensures that the two systems do not interfere with each other and allows for safe inspection and maintenance. In residential or finished areas, the National Electrical Code (NEC) allows 1.5 inches (≈ 38 mm) separation for NM cables crossing gas lines.

Additional Safety Considerations

- **Maintenance Access:** Adequate spacing ensures that both cable trays and gas pipes can be inspected, repaired, or replaced without obstruction.
