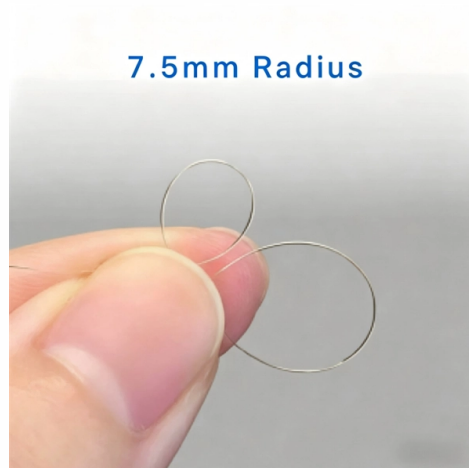


Fiber Optic Communication Protection Ring Network

Self-Healing Rings

A self-healing ring automatically reroutes traffic when a failure occurs. Mechanisms like Automatic Protection Switching (APS) detect signal loss or degradation and switch the data path to a backup route within milliseconds, ensuring minimal disruption.
