

Home broadband fiber optic cables do not require a fusion splicer

Fiber optic cable mechanical splicing is an alternate splicing technique that does not require a fusion splicer. However, bulk cable alone won't make an installation — fiber requires connector termination to integrate electronics and, thankfully, the tools required to install optical connectors have also become more affordable and easier to use. Once the two optical fibers are joined with a splice, they cannot be taken apart.
