Materials are typically copper or aluminum, often tinned for corrosion resistance in humid or coastal environments . Step 2: Identify Installation Location

Inside the distribution box, look for locations marked with a ground symbol. Ground bars can usually be installed on multiple sides of the panel, but avoid interference with service entrance cables, feeder cables, or other wiring . Proper placement prevents cable chafing and allows easy access for future maintenance.

Step 3: Secure the Busbar

- Align the busbar with the designated nubs and screw holes in the panel .
- Use suitable hardware, including a star tooth washer and nut, to ensure a solid connection to the panel's metal frame .
