

How to ground a power fiber optic cable



Overview

In installations where an optical fiber cable is exposed to contact with electric light or power conductors and the cable enters the building, the non-current-carrying metallic members shall be either grounded as specified in 770. However, this does not mean every fiber optic installation is exempt from grounding requirements. To promote safe and effective bonding and grounding methods of armored optical cables, the National Electrical Code (NEC) and many industry standards have been. This Applications Engineering Note (AE Note) discusses conventional bonding and grounding practices for conductive fiber optic cable and hardware installations within the scope of the National Electrical Code (NEC). Two types of armoring exist: interlocking and corrugated. Interlocking armor is an aluminum armor that is helically wrapped around the cable and found in indoor and indoor/outdoor cables. These cables include metallic components that can carry electrical currents, presenting potential hazards such as electrical shock or fire.
