

How to install a secondary distribution box

A secondary distribution box, or subpanel, should be installed with careful attention to location, wiring, grounding, and compliance with electrical codes to ensure safety and reliable power distribution.

1. Planning and Site Selection

Choose a dry, accessible, and well-ventilated location for the subpanel, avoiding damp areas, flammable materials, or corrosive environments. Ensure clear working space around the panel: at least 3 feet in front, 30 inches wide, and extending from the floor to 6.5 feet, as required by NEC Article 110.26 . The panel should be close to the intended load to minimize long wire runs and facilitate maintenance . For residential setups, a height of approximately 1.5 meters above the floor is recommended .

2. Selecting the Subpanel and Components

- Subpanel size: Choose a panel with enough slots for current and future circuits.
- Circuit breakers: Each branch circuit should have its own breaker.
- Enclosure rating: For indoor use, NEMA 1 or IP20 is sufficient; for outdoor or humid areas, use NEMA 4 or IP66 .
- Feeder wires: Typically, four wires are required—two hot, one neutral, and one equipment ground .
