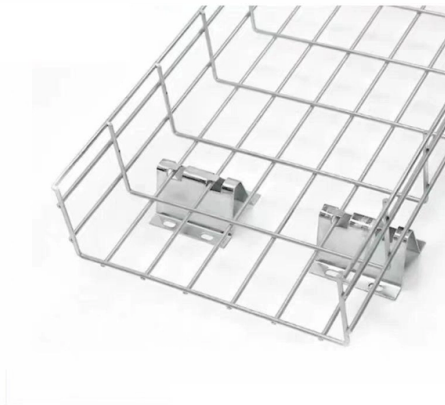

The government has laid approximately 4.19 million km of optical fiber, with the BharatNet Phase-3 project aiming to connect and upgrade over 211,000 gram panchayats, significantly boosting rural connectivity and reducing access costs for ISPs and telcos. The National Highways Authority of India is also deploying fiber along 146,000 km of highways under a public-private partnership, supporting smart roads, barrier-free tolling, and commercial leasing.

Role of Private Sector and Global Tech Companies

Major Indian telcos like Reliance Jio, Bharti Airtel, and Tata Communications are heavily investing in fiber to support 4G/5G rollout, FTTH services, and AI-driven data centers. Global tech giants such as Meta, Google, Microsoft, and Amazon are investing billions in pan-India terrestrial and subsea fiber networks, enhancing data infrastructure and connectivity for cloud and AI services. Industry estimates project India's fiber demand to triple to 60 million fiber kilometers annually, with expectations of 490 million 5G subscribers and 100 million fiber-connected homes by 2030.
