

KVM switcher touchpad not working

Step 3: Power Cycling

- **Full Power Cycle:** Unplug the KVM, all connected computers, and monitors. Wait 5 minutes to discharge capacitors. Reconnect devices, leaving the KVM power supply for last .
- **One Device at a Time:** If the touchpad still fails, connect only one computer and the touchpad to isolate the issue .
