- **Residual Current Devices (RCDs) / RCBOs:** Detect imbalances between live and neutral wires to prevent electric shocks .
- **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that distribute electricity from the main input to individual breakers .
- **Neutral and Grounding Links:** Provide safe return paths for current and protect against electrical faults .
