

Main Lighting Switch in Distribution Box



AI Overview

The main switch in a lighting distribution box serves as the primary control and safety device, disconnecting power to all lighting circuits simultaneously.

Function and Purpose

The main switch is the central control point of a lighting distribution board (LDB). It allows the entire lighting system to be turned on or off and provides a means to safely isolate the circuits for maintenance or in case of an emergency. It also protects the system by enabling the use of downstream protective devices like MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) and RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) to operate effectively.

Typical Configuration

- **Type of Switch:** In single-phase systems, a double-pole MCB is commonly used as the main switch, handling both phase and neutral lines. In three-phase systems, a three-pole or four-pole MCB may be used depending on the configuration.
- **Rating:** The main switch is rated higher than individual circuit breakers to accommodate the total load of all lighting circuits. For domestic installations, a 63A MCB is typical.
- **Placement:** The main switch is positioned at the incoming supply point of the distribution board, connecting the incoming phase and neutral to the busbars that feed all downstream circuits.
