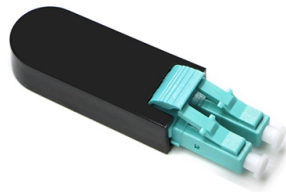


Main line connection method for relocating distribution boxes

Preparation and Safety

Before relocating a distribution box, ensure the power supply is completely turned off and verify with a multimeter. - If a metal conduit (EMT) exists between the old and new locations, conductors can be extended through it, ensuring proper grounding and avoiding back-feeding issues .
