AI Overview

OSFP (Octal Small Form-factor Pluggable) is a high-speed optical transceiver standard designed for 400G, 800G, and beyond, offering eight-lane electrical interfaces with advanced thermal management for data center and AI networking applications.

Overview of OSFP

OSFP is an open standard optical transceiver form factor developed under the OSFP Multi-Source Agreement (MSA) to support ultra-high-speed Ethernet and data center interconnects. Unlike QSFP-DD, OSFP modules are slightly larger, allowing for higher power dissipation (up to 15–20W) and improved thermal performance, which is critical for 400G, 800G, and even 1.6T Ethernet applications. The design prioritizes future scalability, electrical performance, and thermal headroom over port density, making it ideal for AI clusters and hyperscale networks.

Lane Architecture and Bandwidth

The "Octal" in OSFP refers to its eight electrical lanes. Each lane can operate at:

- 50G PAM4 for 400G total bandwidth
 - 100G PAM4 for 800G total bandwidth
 - 200G PAM4 for 1.6T total bandwidth
- This lane architecture reduces crosstalk, simplifies channel equalization, and ensures signal integrity for high-speed connections. OSFP modules are compatible with IEEE 802.3bs and 802.3cd standards for 400G Ethernet.
