Outdoor Drop Cable Installation Techniques

 3. Blown Installation: Compressed air is used to blow microcables through ducts over long distances. This method is robust and allows for future upgrades, though it requires specialized equipment and is more expensive .
 4. Pulling or Pushable Fiber: For short runs, cables can be pulled or manually/mechanically pushed from the cabinet to the premises. Preterminated pushable connectors can eliminate splicing labor and simplify replacement .
- Best Practices: Maintain proper sag for aerial cables, leave service loops for maintenance, segregate fiber from heavy copper cables, and protect cable ends from water ingress .
