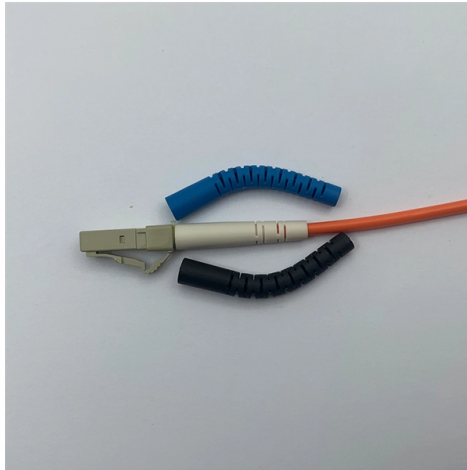


Pulling a cable from the distribution box



AI Overview

Pulling a cable from a distribution box requires careful handling, proper tools, and controlled tension to avoid damage to the cable or the box.

Preparation
