

# Requirements for Office Secondary Distribution Boxes

  - Surge Protective Devices (SPDs) These devices protect circuits from overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults ( ).

- Busbars: Properly rated phase busbars for current distribution
  - Neutral and Earth Bars: Correctly sized and arranged for safe connections
  - DIN Rail Space: Sufficient for mounting protective devices
