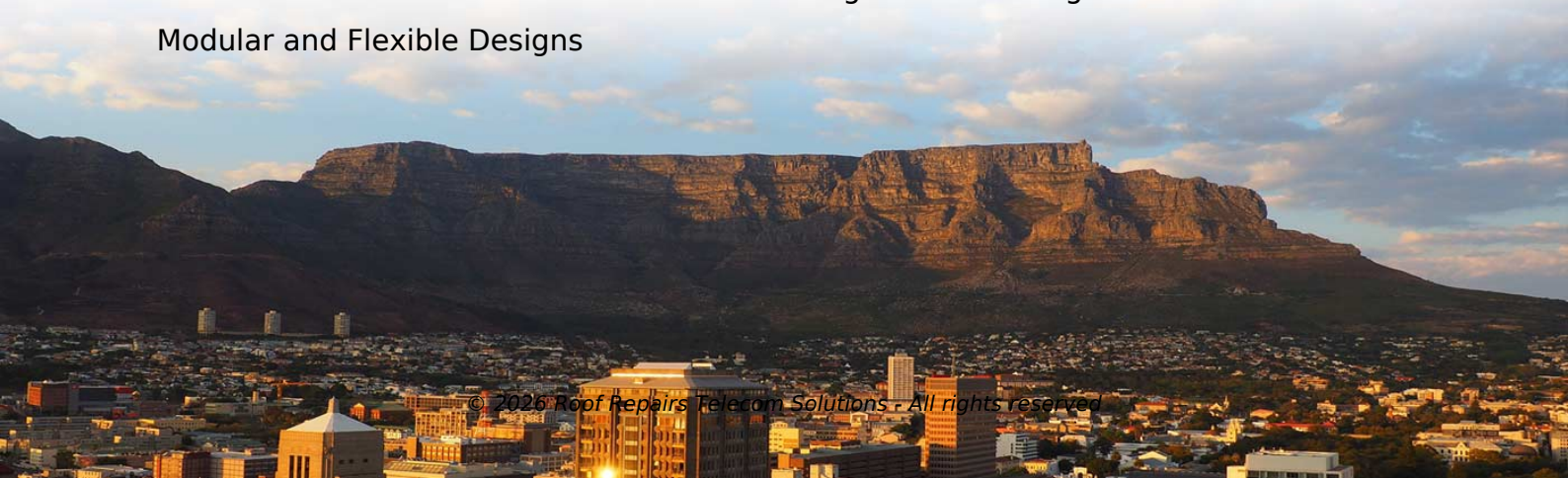
Renewable Energy Integration

These materials are durable, corrosion-resistant, and often modular, allowing for easier assembly, disassembly, and relocation. For example, laminated wooden towers can last up to 30 years and are naturally fire-retardant, while GFRP towers reduce CO2 emissions during manufacturing and installation .
