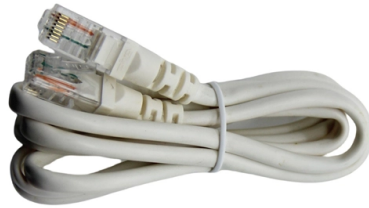


The front shelf is made with two aisles
