This function is sensitive to the fundamental. Phase overcurrent relays and residual overcurrent relays are often used to provide main earth-fault protection of MV feeders. The relays may have independent time or dependent time characteristics and may or may not be combined with a directional element. Neutral displacement voltage and neutral.
