Fiber and Connector Selection

For duplex LC or SC connections, this is straightforward, but for MPO/MTP multi-fiber connections, polarity must be managed using Type A (straight-through), Type B (reversed), or Type C (pair-flipped) patch cords .

Using MPO Patch Cords and Adapters

For parallel optical modules (e.g., 40G-SR4, 100G-SR4), MPO patch cords connect the module to backbone cables. MPO adapters may be used to link patch cords, with Type A adapters matching key-up to key-down, and Type B adapters matching key-up to key-up . The fiber arrangement must follow the chosen polarity method to ensure each Tx connects to the correct Rx.
