

Which cable should the splitter be plugged into



Overview

Splitters work by utilizing the eight wires inside a standard Category 5e (or better) Ethernet cable, which are typically wired as four pairs. When you need to connect multiple wired devices like computers, printers, and IP phones, but only have one Ethernet wall port, using an Ethernet splitter or network switch can expand your connectivity without rewiring. This comes in handy, especially when there are many gadgets. It takes an existing wired Ethernet connection, and splits it off into two, giving you the ability to connect what is effective, a single Ethernet connection, and share it between two distinct devices. Generally, Ethernet cables have four twisted copper wire pairs: Fast.
